

# Dial Up Set Up Instructions

## Step One:

1. Double click on "my computer".
2. Double click on "Dial-up Networking" icon. If there is not an icon there then you need to install the dialup-networking portion of your windows 95/98 software. This must be done before you can continue.
3. Once in "Dialup Networking" double click on "Make New Connection".
4. Name your connection "Segnet" and click next.
5. Enter the number given to you by your account rep.
6. Click next and then click finish.
7. You now have an icon named "Segnet".
8. Right click on the "Segnet" icon, and choose "Properties".
9. Click on "Server Type", Verify that "Dial-up Server type is PPP..."  
In advanced options click "TCP/IP" It should be the only box checked.
10. Click "OK" until you are out of setup.

## Step Two:

1. Double click on the connection icon you just created (Segnet).
2. Enter the user name and password as was sent to you.
3. Click connect. If everything is set up correctly, your modem will dial and you will be promptly connected. If something is wrong windows will give you an error message. One common mistake is that the caps lock is on. The password is case sensitive. Please use all lower case when typing in your username, and password. If you get an error try typing in your username and password again.
